FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

Dear Parents,

As Michaelann Martin once said, "It seems fitting that Advent is the beginning of the liturgical calendar, for it is a season of spiritual preparation marked by an eager longing for the birth of Our Savior Jesus Christ." It encourages us to live closer to Christ and utilize the time to share our faith and traditions with our family and school community. We will gather together for the final time Monday morning for our Advent Wreath Ceremony with an emphasis on prayer and song. It is a wonderful time of year! Please remember to send in hats and mittens for the children. It was very cold earlier this week and we certainly expect similar temperatures over the next few months. We want to give our students the opportunity to play outside as often as possible so thank you for your cooperation.

Our second round of standardized testing will commence Monday, January 8th and the last day for testing is Friday, January 26th. Our third through seventh grade students will once again be assessed in Reading, Language Arts, and Math to check their progression in these particular areas. Please make every attempt to have your child/ren here during this testing window to minimize make-up assessments and alternative schedules.

Believe it or not, it is almost time to begin re-registration for the 2018-2019 school year! Re-registration will begin on Wednesday, January 17th for current students and siblings and will close on Saturday, February 3rd. Open registration will begin Monday, February 5 for new students. FACTS scholarship applications for tuition assistance are due before **March 16, 2017.** If applicable, please complete your application as soon as possible in order to qualify for the Diocesan Tuition Assistance and/or the Diocesan Scholarship Fund. Parish assistance is always limited so please complete your application as soon as possible.

Tuition will increase 4% for the 2018-2019 school year. To remain transparent, I would like to note that the actual cost per student at SJES is actually \$6, 730. This indicates that each child is already receiving a subsidy from the parish independent from any type of financial assistance. We remain indebted to the Diocese of Arlington, Father Gould, and the parish for their continued investment in Catholic education.

Below are the 2018-2019 tuition rates for your convenience:

Catholic families will be charged \$6,190 (\$20/month increase) for one child, \$11,090 (\$35/month increase) for two children, \$15,070 (\$48/month increase) for three children, and \$16,640 (\$53/month increase) for four children. Any additional students from the same family may attend at no cost and families of other faiths will pay \$9,220 per child. The Diocese of Arlington continues to ask that parish schools be less dependent upon the church.

In an effort to limit increases, the Materials Fee will continue to remain at \$250/child. This fee includes the cost of maintaining equipment used for student instruction, software licensing, workbooks, and other consumable supplies. The Materials Fee will be added to the FACTS account. You will receive more information regarding deadlines for the Materials Fee in the new year.

In closing, be attentive, be reflective, and be responsible to Christ during this advent season. Merry Christmas to one and all and may we continue to grow in God's grace and wisdom.

DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM Office of Catholic Schools occidence dystesign

What is the program?

The Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program provides financial assistance to families in Catholic schools in the Diocese of Arlington through funding from diocesan parishes as well as the Rooted in Faith~Forward in Hope Capital Campaign Endowment. It is open to all qualified students whose parents might not otherwise be able to pay the full cost of tuition.

Who is eligible?

- Students attending or accepted by a Diocese of Arlington Catholic school (K-12).
 - Preschool and Pre-K are not eligible.
 - Not applicable to students of private Catholic schools associated with the Diocese and/or international students.
- Students who are Catholic and members of a parish in the Diocese of Arlington or military base parish.
- Families who reside within the boundaries of the Diocese of Arlington and are registered and active members of a diocesan parish or a military base parish.

How do I apply?

- Submit financial aid assessment application and all supporting tax documentation by due date
 - Applications will be completed electronically online at online.factsmgt.com/Signin
 - Only one application is required per family.
- Remit processing fee.
- Families seeking aid for students in BOTH ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL should follow the high school submission date.

Due Dates: HIGH SCHOOL January 22, 2018

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL March 16, 2018

Awards

Awards are made for ONE ACADEMIC YEAR and are based on each family's demonstrated financial need. Individual schools determine the amount and the distribution of all awards for each academic year. The schools will contact families when award decisions have been made. Once these final award decisions have been made, the schools will then credit the tuition accounts of approved families.


