FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Greetings,

I am pleased to announce that St. John will offer an Advanced Math Program for middle school students beginning next year. This initiative will be phased in over three years so our current 5th graders will be the first group eligible for Geometry at the 8th grade level. Our rising sixth graders have completed 5th grade Honor's Math and several of these students will have the opportunity to take Pre-Algebra next year. Those who remain on our Advanced Math Track will be eligible for Algebra in 7th grade in 2018-2019 and will be the first students to take Geometry as eighth graders in 2019-2020.

The sixth grade class will split next year to accommodate this new program and we are thrilled to offer smaller class sizes at the middle school level. The eventual split moving forward will certainly maximize instruction and increase student learning. Our Honor's Program, lead by Mrs. Galvin and Mrs. Paccassi, will gather data including our recent round of Scantron testing and begin formulating letters that will go home for both Advanced Math and Middle School Honor's Literature before the end of the school year.

Speaking of the end of the year, this is another reminder for all parents to please record your volunteer hours. After May 31, our PTO members will gather all volunteer hours and begin to identify the families who met and did not meet their volunteer requirements. The PTO graciously reduced the number of hours needed so we are hoping that those who fell short of this expectation will make a donation totaling the number of hours that were missed. Two parent households were expected to volunteer 20 hours this year while single parents were expected to volunteer 10 hours of their time. If you are assisting with the CYO Sports Banquet, Field Trips, Field Day, or Graduation, please record your hours before May 31st. Thank you for your involvement and cooperation in our school activities and commitment to service.

It is that time of year. Graduation is now in sight for our Kindergarten and our 8th grade students. We will be sad to see them go but God always provides either sooner or later! Congratulations to our preschool students who were excellent at their Spring Program Wednesday evening.
