Dear St. John Families,

The Diocese of Arlington Office of Catholic Schools and St John School continues to work with Local Health Departments and is closely monitoring the health crisis in China and globally associated with novel coronavirus infections (COVID-19). According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), risk to the U.S. public remains low. There are no cases of COVID-19 infection in Virginia and the Virginia Health Departments do not recommend school closures at this time.

The CDC has issued travel warnings for China and South Korea to avoid all non-essential travel due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The CDC provides guidance to travelers and information regarding other destinations with apparent community spread at the following site:

Preventative measures are the same ones we take to prevent the spread of the flu, the common cold and other viruses. The best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed to this virus. The CDC recommends these preventive actions:

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcoholbased hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

Stay home when you are sick.

Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash, then wash your hands as mentioned above.

Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

In addition, school guidelines state that students need to be *fever free for 24 hours* ( CDC considers a person to have a fever when he or she has a measured temperature of at least 100.4 °F [38 °C] ) without the use of fever reducing medication before returning. The 24-hour rule also applies to illnesses involving diarrhea. Your Primary Health Care Provider, local Health Department and the CDC website have

DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRA

### Academic Year 2020-2021

#### What is the program?

The Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program provides financial assistance to families in Catholic schools in the Diocese of Arlington through funding from diocesan parishes as well as the Rooted in Faith~Forward in Hope Capital Campaign Endowment. It is open to all qualified students whose parents might not otherwise be able to pay the full cost of tuition.

#### Who is eligible?

- Students attending or accepted by a Diocese of Arlington Catholic school (K-12).
  - Preschool and Pre-K are not eligible.
  - Not applicable to students of private Catholic schools associated with the Diocese and/or international students.
- Students who are Catholic and members of a parish in the Diocese of Arlington or military base parish.
- Families who reside within the boundaries of the Diocese of Arlington and are registered and active members of a diocesan parish or a military base parish.

#### How do I apply?

- Submit financial aid assessment application and all supporting tax documentation by due date
  - Applications will be completed electronically online at <u>online.factsmgt.com/Signin</u>
    Only one application is required per family.
- Remit processing fee.
- Families seeking aid for students in BOTH ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL should follow the high school submission date.

January 10, 2020 March 18, 2020

#### Awards

Awards are made for ONE ACADEMIC YEAR and are based on each family's demonstrated financial need. Individual schools determine the amount and the distribution of all awards for each academic year. The schools will contact families when award decisions have been made. Once these final award decisions have been made, the schools will then credit the tuition accounts of approved families.

### **Instructions to Complete the Application**

Step 1: Use the following URL to log into the OPCYP Background Check Application site:

https://secure4.arlingtondiocese.org/OPCYP Application/

- **Step 2:** If you are a new user, choose "Create Account." If you have logged in before, please use your Username and Password. If you have forgotten it, please input your email address and reset your password.
- **<u>Step 3:</u>** Provide all the information requested and answer the questions as thoroughly as possible.
- Step 4: Once you have completed the application, please print a copy of the Central Registry Form before selecting the Red Finish Button (ONLY if you are able to print double sided if not the school liaison will print one for you). This document is required to get notarized by you and then turned in to the school office. The school office will then mail this form out. You may contact our Parish Office at 540-347-2922 to schedule an appointment to have this form notarized free of charge by Rosemary Coakley.
- **Step 5:** The OPCYP Liaison will be reviewing your paperwork to ensure all the information has been correctly entered. If there is a question or an issue with your paperwork an email will be sent with instructions explaining the issue(s) and the next steps.
- Please keep your Username and Password in a safe place. It is the key to access your OPCYP portal.
- **Step 6:** Now that you have completed the online Background Check Application Process you will need to schedule your VIRTUS training course. Please find scheduling information for VIRTUS at the website provided below.


