Although we cannot share all the specifics publicly at this time, I am delighted to share that our DFE visit went very well. The Visiting Team rightfully recognized that the heart of our school community is the Eucharist. By offering continuous inperson instruction and weekly mass for each grade, we have been able to return to the "source and summit of the Christian life" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1324), as referenced in their summary. Time away from the lengthy report will be necessary after an intense Self-Study process but in the near future, we will reflect on the Visiting Team's recommendations, as well as our own, to design our next five year Strategic Plan. This revolving cycle encourages us to be better six years from now than we are today. That is always a good thing.

As a reminder, we have partnered with Catholic Relief Services yet again through the Rice Bowl project. This gives all of us the opportunity to follow the Good Samaritan's example and practice what we preach. Holy Week is right around the corner and it is our hope that your family was able to embrace Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving this Lenten season. Referencing the latter, I was delighted to hear from several students that their Rice Bowl boxes are nearing capacity. \$40 helps provide 1 month of food for a family, 2 years of seed for a farmer, and 1 emergency kit for refugees.



ART, DRAMA, MUSICAL THEATRE CAMPS for K-12



What is the program?

The Dioceson Tuition Assistance Program provides financial assistance to families in Catholic schools in the Dioceso of Arlington through funding from diaceson parishes as well as the *Rooted in Fallh-Farward in Hape* Capital Campaign Endowment. It is open to all qualified students whose parents might not otherwise be able to pay the full cost of tuition.

Who is eligible?

- Students attending or accepted by a Diocese of Arington Catholic school (K-12).
 - Preschool and Pre-K are not eligible.
 - Not applicable to students of private Catholic schools associated with the Diocese and/or international students.
- Students who are Catholic and members of a parish in the Diocese of Arlington or military base parish.
- Families who reside within the boundaries of the Diocese of Arlington and are registered and active members of a diocesan parish or a military base parish.

How do I apply?

- Submit financial aid assessment application and all supporting tax documentation by due date
 Applications will be completed electronically online at <u>online.factsmgt.com/Signin</u>
 Only one application is required per family.
- Remit processing fee.
- Families seeking aid for sludents in BOTH ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL should follow the high school submission date.
